Accelerated Class For Teenage Driver's Education
June 9 – 19, 2014

COURSE Driver Education for teenagers consists of 2 phases. The classroom phase meets for thirty-six 50-minute periods. Behind The Wheel meets for fourteen 50-minute periods. Any student not passing the Road Test will be held back for a minimum of 30 days to gain practice. A fee will be assessed if a 2nd Road Test is given. The instruction provided does not guarantee that any student will pass the state license examination or that the student can secure a license or that the student will be guaranteed employment upon completion of any course instruction. It is the responsibility of the student or in the case of a minor parent or legal guardian, to report to the Department of Motor Vehicles any concerns regarding school facilities, instructor behavior or quality of instruction by the school.

SCHEDULE The classroom course meets from 8:30am - 12:30pm daily for 9 weekdays. Behind The Wheel normally begins immediately after completion of the classroom phase (students must have obtained their Learners Permit for BTW). Students must find their own transportation to and from the classroom location. We pick up students at an agreed upon location (such as their home, school or other centrally located area) for Behind the Wheel.

LOCATION The classroom portion is held at Virginia Western Community College, located at 3095 Colonial Ave SW, Roanoke, Virginia. The classroom location will be held in Webber 308 (Map of VWCC on back of this form).

METHOD OF INSTRUCTION Text assignments, guest speakers, and written tests.

INSTRUCTORS All classroom and in-car instruction is provided by professional educators and are licensed by the Department of Motor Vehicles of Virginia.

CREDENTIALS Licensed by the Virginia Department of Motor Vehicles for training persons under 19 years of age. Driver Education Certificate and Insurance Credit Certificate issued upon successful completion of the course. Vicki Osborne has a Bachelor of Science degree from Radford University with a major in Health, Physical Education, and Driver's Education and a Master of Science in Education from VPI.

FEES **Driver Education Classroom phase..... \$120.00 (Make check payable to VWCC).**
Classroom is limited in size. Please return the application (with payment) within 5 days of receipt of these forms. Fees include textbook usage. All textbooks must be returned in good condition upon completion of the course or a \$15.00 charge will be assessed before the student's certificate will be issued. The classroom fee is non-refundable after 4 classroom periods. Otherwise a full refund less a \$30.00 service charge will be made. Any student missing a class period must make-up this time per DMV. The student will have the option of coming into a following class taught at no charge or time will be scheduled after the completion of the class at the rate of an adult lesson (\$40/hr). If more than one student needs to make-up time they will split the appropriate fees.

Behind-The-Wheel Phase.....\$275.00* (Make check payable to Driving For All Ages, Inc.).
Payable in advance; 7 periods behind the wheel and 7 periods as an observer. Situations may arise that the student will drive "one on one" with the instructor. All observation hours require at least one other student in the vehicle. Students are normally scheduled for Behind the Wheel training in the order in which they obtained their Learner's Permit and can drive "solo". The student and/or parent will pay any damage caused by student to vehicle due to willful negligence (not an accident), up to \$500. Refunds will be calculated for the 1st 2 periods of BTW instruction based upon the hourly rate for a private lesson. After 2 periods of BTW instruction, only \$50 will be refunded if termination is necessary by either party. Students do not have to complete their 45 driving hours with their parent before starting the Behind the Wheel Phase.

* BTW fees guaranteed for 9 months after the completion of the classroom phase.
